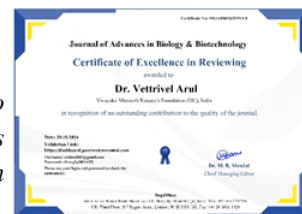


AWARENESS PROGRAMME PHARMACOVIGILANCE IN AYUSH SYSTEM

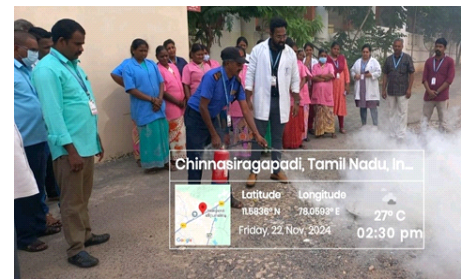
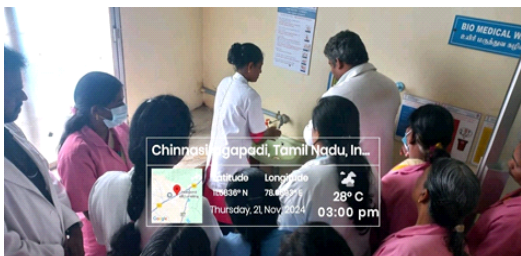
CODE BLUE AND TRIAGE CODE ON 19.11.2024

CODE PINK TRAINING AND MOCK DRILL on 20.11.2024



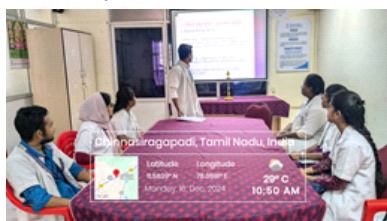
CODE BROWN AND HAND HYGIENE TRAINING AND MOCK DRILL on 21.11.2024
