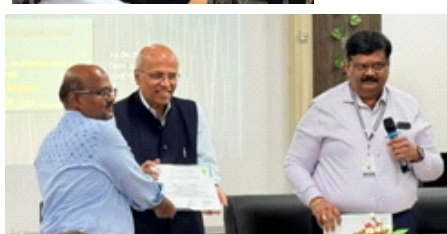
GOOD CLINICAL PRACTICE (GCP) TRAINING PROGRAMME

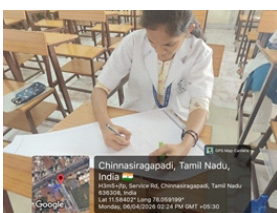
MARAKKUMA NENJAM – A FAREWELL TO REMEMBER

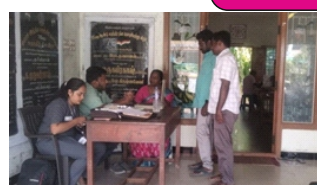
NABL ASSESSMENT – APRIL 2026

Free blood Glucose screening was provided for patients requiring investigation and individuals in need of further evaluation and management were advised to attend the outpatient Department of the college hospital for follow-up and care. Altogether, seven medical camps were organized at various locations, benefiting more than 500 patients through consultation, health screening, preventive care and homoeopathic treatment services.

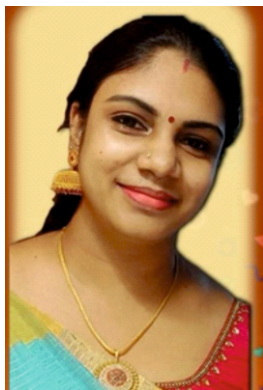
WORLD HOMOEOPATHY DAY – ALUMNI LECTURE SERIES

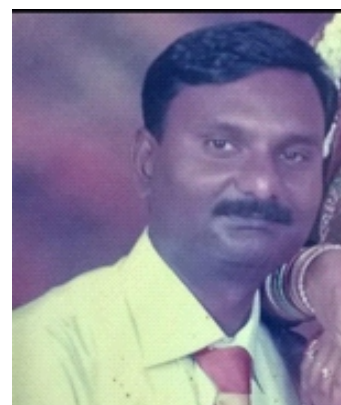
